6. What are some successful church-planting strategies that OMF missionary Elisabeth Weinmann uses in her ministry?
7. In what ways can missionaries more effectively reach Taiwan’s working class?
8. In what ways can your church or fellowship group get involved in the work God is doing among Taiwan’s working class?
9. In what ways can *you* be involved?
